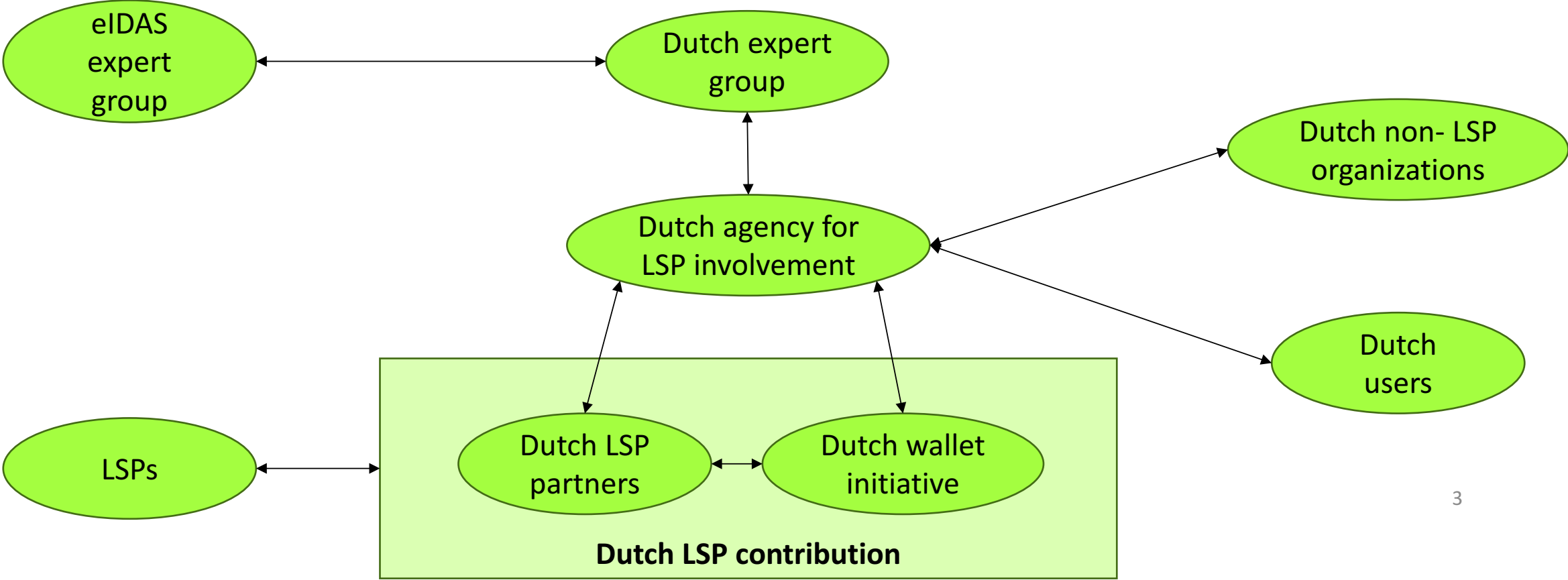

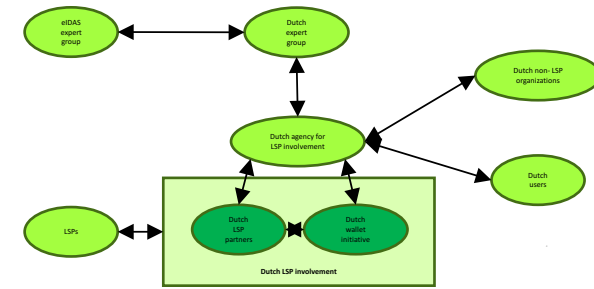

Overview of Dutch approach



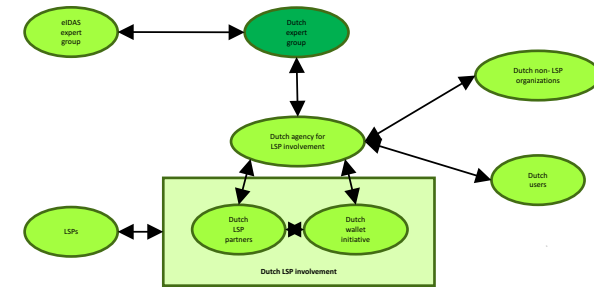
Dutch LSP contribution



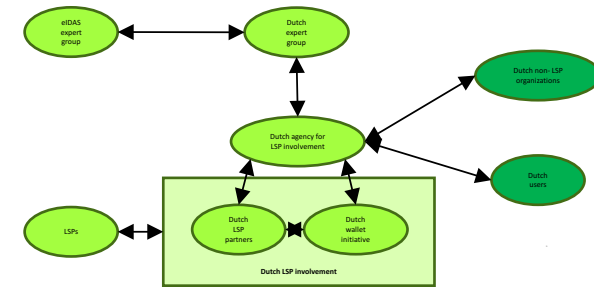
- Dutch wallet initiative
 - Develops wallet
 - Develops Dutch governance for the wallet infrastructure
 - Much attention for UX/UI and inclusivity
- Dutch public and private organizations
 - Contribute to LSPs, being an issuer, walletprovider, relying party, ...
 - Share their experiences during national events
 - Find each other to make agreements and find solutions

Dutch expert group

- Reviews and comments implementing acts
- Contributes to eIDAS expert group
- Contributes to development of Dutch wallet
- Support Dutch partners in LSPs

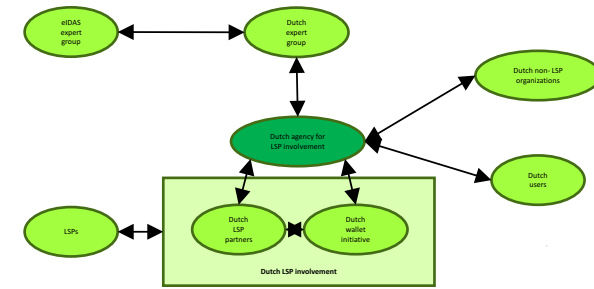


Dutch parties not in LSPs



- Public and private organisations
 - Are not always aware of the regulation, nor actively preparing
 - See value in international use
 - See a logic in combining wallet implementation with the OOTS
 - Need/want the lessons learned from LSPs
- Users
 - Often unaware of eIDAS2
 - Want simple, fast, easy, safe solutions that bring something extra
 - Trust (and with that adoption) will come slowly

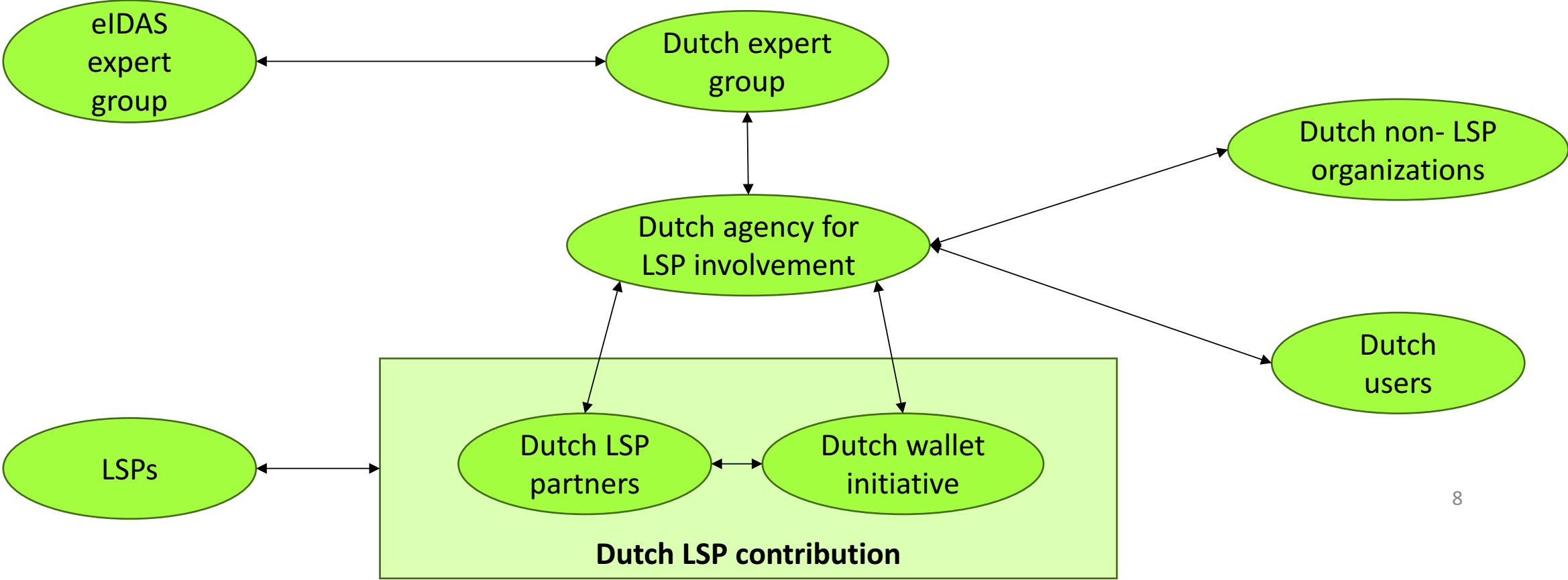
Dutch agency for LSP involvement



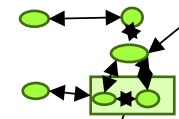
- Coordinates contributions to bid documents
- Recruits public and private partners for new LSPs
- Supports Dutch LSP partners with administrative procedures
- Facilitates Dutch LSP partners exchange and networking
- Initiates deep-dives in common topics
- Addresses commonly experienced issues

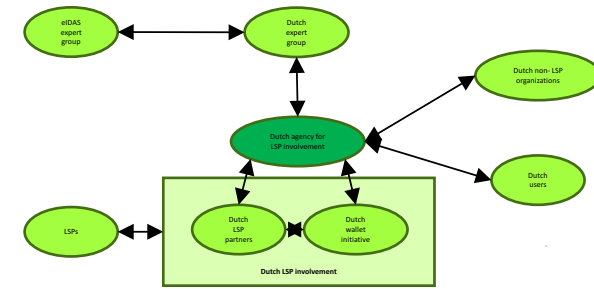




- Consolidates lessons learned from all LSPs
- Translates this to structured, small-sized chunks of information
- Shares this in a tailor-made way
- To public and private organizations in The Netherlands
- That were not involved in LSPs
- But are bound to the regulation and need to implement eIDAS2
- This way, 'the rest of NL' will become aware and understand what needs to be done for implementing

Status

- NL wallet nationally piloted
- NL wallet Initial focus on Natural Persons
- High public/private involvement in LSPs (>200 in 1st and 2nd gen.)
- Roadmap and building blocks for stimulating adoption in NL
- Supporting small scale pilots, often with both wallet and OOTS
- Creating many opportunities for sharing and networking

LSP and beyond

- 
- Use the LSPs to ‘learn by doing’
 - Coordinating and facilitating the contribution and involvements yields high and durable participation
 - Experiencing first hand to really learn

 - And now from LSP to AOI (All-Out Implementation)

 - The rest of the country ‘has no idea’
 - Adoption needs to be actively initiated and nourished
 - At the side of suppliers (infrastructure, attestations, services())
 - At the side of users (people, companies)
 - Don’t let the knowledge gained in an LSP end up in a drawer
